MY FAMILY'S FARM BY RAUL OLARTE - ESL STUDENT






My father and uncle have a sugar cane farm in Villetta Cundinamarca, Columbia. Villeta is a small town that is located about 80 kilometers from Bogota, the nation's capital.

On our family farm, we grow sugar cane. We plant the sugar cane just before the start of the rainy season. It takes almost a year before the crop is ready to be harvested. Family workers cut the sugar cane stalks and bring them to the arbor, known in Spanish as an enrramada, to be processed. First, the stalks are piled up, then are put through a machine that separates the juice from them. The sugar cane juice then runs into a boiler, which heats it. When the liquid is hot and reaches a certain temperature, the bark of a tree called guasimo is introduced. This helps to remove all impurities from the sugar cane juice. When the liquid is purified, it goes into the next boiler kettle and is fire heated to remove any remaining impurities. After 20 minutes, the liquid is passed to the third boiler to give it the necessary thickness.

The thickened juice is spread into molds of a wooden container and separated into square or rectangular shapes. The sugar cane liquid then cools and hardens for about 10 minutes, forming blocks of solid sugar cane called "panela". The blocks of panela are removed from the molds and are packed into cardboard boxes to be taken into town and sold.

Panela is sold across the world and can be enjoyed in its solid form or further processed into cane sugar or white sugar. This is a delicious product that is used in many ways sweets, baking, you-nameit! It's great that my family produces a sweet product that is enjoyed in many different ways by people world-wide.

Place Names

Place names in Alberta come from many different sources and can be strange or funny, but they are mostly either named after a person, some other place, or are First Nations in origin.

Around Calgary, there are many small towns that are named after rich and powerful people of the 1800s. Examples of this include Cochrane and Langdon, which are named after people who worked for the Canadian Pacific Railway when the railway was being built. Other examples of places named after a person is Nanton, which was the name of a famous rancher in the area; Lethbridge, named after a coal mine executive; and Saints Albert and Paul, which were named after Saints.

Places named after other places include the two largest cities in the province, Calgary and Edmonton. Calgary and Banff are both places in Scotland, while Edmonton is a borough of Metropolitan London. These received their names from people who wanted to name a new place after one that was important to them.

First Nations names are very common in Alberta, as most everything here was named before European settlers came. Close to Calgary, we have Okotoks, which was named after the large glacial irregular just west of the city—it literally means Big Rock in the Siksika language. There are many other Alberta locations with original First nations names such as Wetaskiwin, Ponoka, and Kananaskis. Some, such as Medicine Hat, Red Deer, High River and Grande Prairie are translations of the original First Nations names.

The most interesting names in Western Canada are those on the Alphabet Line of what is now the Canadian National Railway. When it was built, there needed to be a railway station every eight miles, so they needed to have a lot of names. To make the naming easier, they decided to begin with Arona, Manitoba. This process was followed with many exceptions all the way to Entrance, Alberta, which is near the entrance to Jasper National Park, over four times through the alphabet.





Let's cook!

Chicken salad by Fargiva - LINC student



Mexican Green

Pozole

by Martha

- 1 can of hominy 108 oz (3.06 Kg)
- 1 breast of chicken
- 2 garlic cloves,
- 2 tbsp salt
- 1 ½ kg. tomatillos (find these at the Mexican market and even in some general markets now. It could be fresh or it could be from a can)
- ½ white onion
- 1 or ½ serrano pepper
- 2 poblano peppers.
- up to 2 cups of water
- ½ lettuce iceberg (choped)
- 1 bunch radishes (small pieces) 2 avocados
 - 8-10 limes
 - dry Mexican oregano leaves
 - 1-2 pack tostadas or tortilla chips.

Clean the chicken and place it in boil water with 1/8 of the White onion and a clean garlic clove.

Once is cooked put it on a side, cut or shred the chicken in pieces. You will add the chicken at the end.

Open the can of hominy and rinse well in a colander until the water is clear. Place the hominy in your largest pot with the chicken broth, considering the hominy and the chicken are going to need to fit.

Add water until the hominy is cover.

In another pot put 1 ½ kg of tomatillos (peeled and wash) with water and boil until cooked. Let it cool down.

In a blender, mix well 1 clove of peeled garlic, the rest of the onion, kilo y medio of tomatillos (peeled and wash), serrano pepper (to taste, ½ for flavor, 1 for spicy), salt.

Add up to 1 cups of water in order to blend smoothly.

Add the salsa to the soup pot with the hominy and let it simmer for 15-20 minutes on low heat until the salsa changes in color from bright green to olive green.

Wash the lettuce and finely chop. Wash and finely slice the radishes or cut them in cubs.
